



MyRoto new login instructions

Effective May 4, 2026, Maxcess and RotoMetrics have made updates to the [myroto.com](https://www.myroto.com) login process to enhance website security and improve the customer experience. All current MyRoto users will be required to briefly verify their email & password the next time they login.

Logging in for the First Time

When logging in for the first time, you will need to take a few extra steps to create your SSO login.

Step 1: MyRoto Login

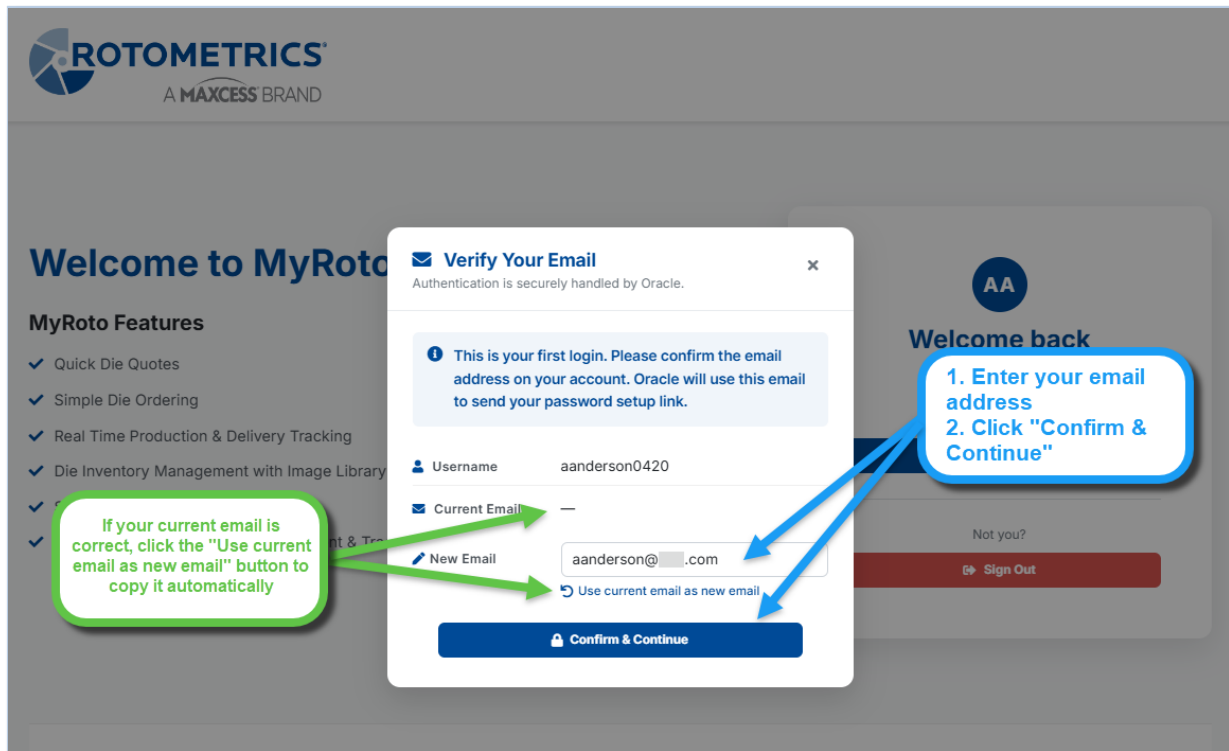
Start at the MyRoto home page (<https://www.myroto.com/>)

A dialog will appear. You will need to confirm your email address.





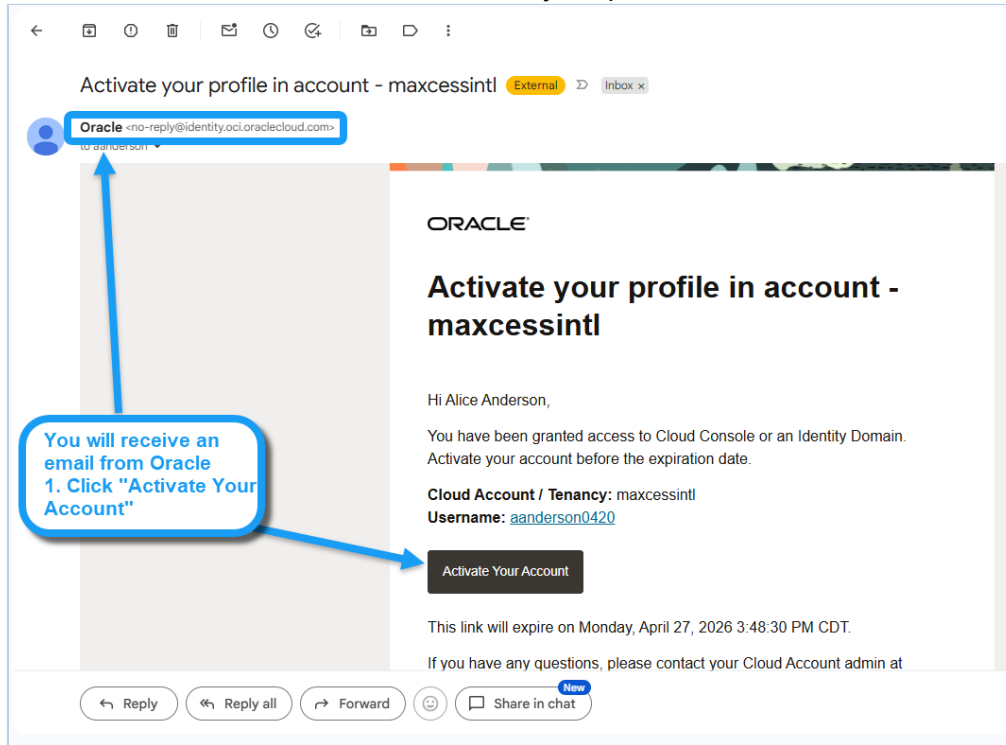
If the **Current Email** is the one you would like to use, click the **Use current email as new email** button to copy it to the **New Email** field.

Otherwise:

1. Enter your email address in the **New Email** field
2. Click the **Confirm & Continue** button

Step 2: Confirm your email address and activate your profile

Check your email for an email from Oracle titled “Activate your profile in account – maxcessintl”



1. Click the **Activate Your Account** link in the email

- The password cannot exceed 40 characters.
- The password cannot contain the First Name of the user.
- The password cannot contain the Last Name of the user.
- The password cannot contain the user name.
- The password must have at least 1 lowercase characters.
- The password must have at least 1 uppercase characters.
- The password must have at least 1 numeric characters.
- Cannot repeat last 4 passwords

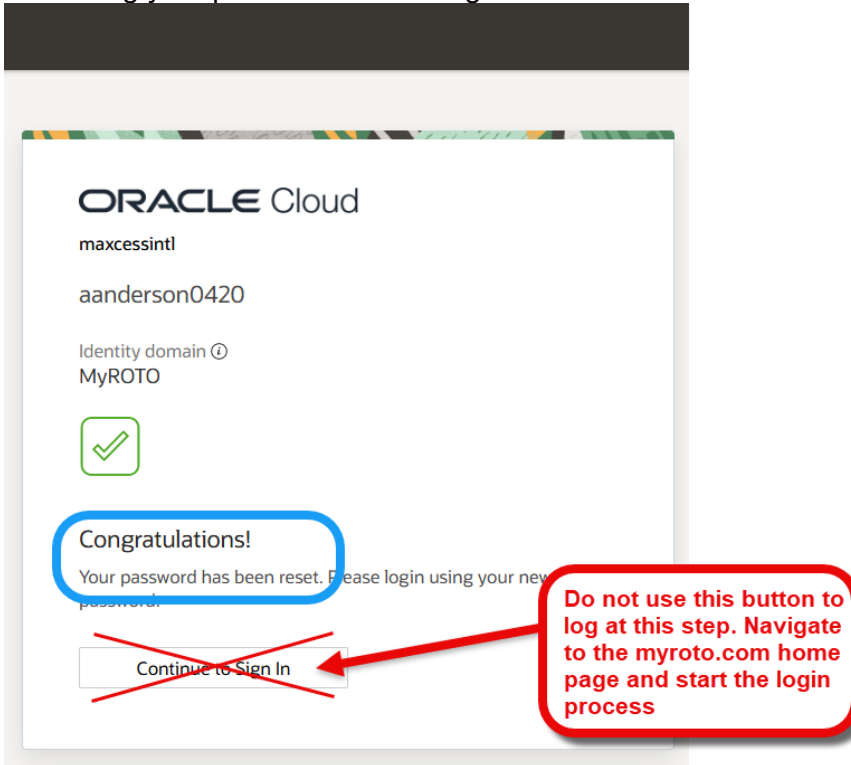

Reset Password

1. Create and confirm a new password
2. Click "Reset Password"

1. Create and confirm a new password. The password must:
 - Be between 12 and 40 characters
 - Not contain your First Name, Last Name or username
 - Have at least 1 lowercase character
 - Must have at least 1 uppercase character
 - Must have at least 1 numeric character
 - Not repeat your last 4 passwords
2. Click the **Reset Password** button

You will receive a message that your password has been reset. You will also receive an email from Oracle confirming your password has changed.

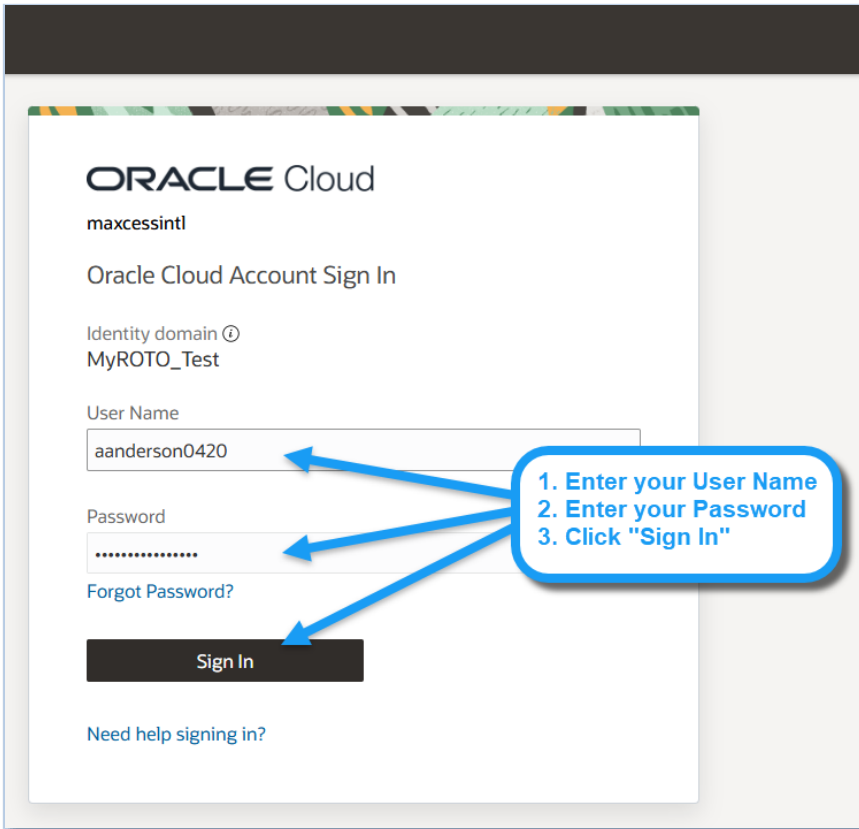


DO NOT CLICK the **Continue To Sign In** button. Instead, go back to the MyRoto home page at <https://www.myroto.com/>

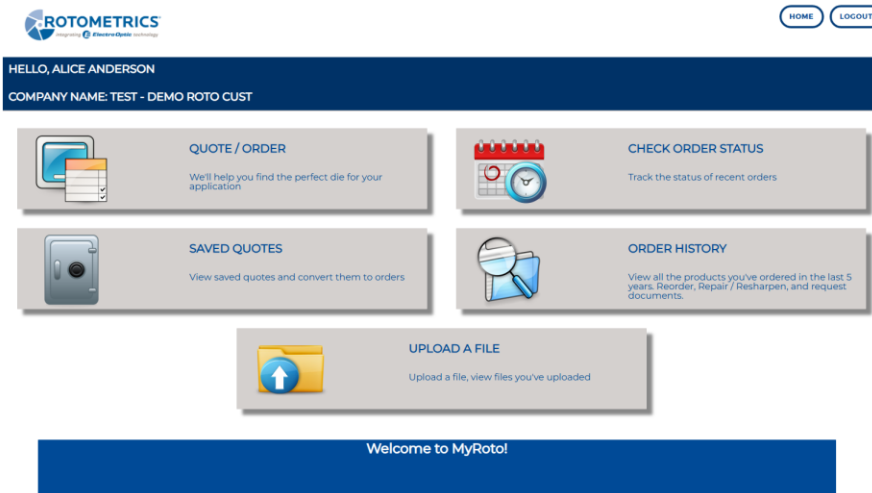
1. Enter your MyRoto Username
